



























Type	Variety	Description	
Broccoli	Batavia 62 days	Vigorous early broccoli with nutty sweet flavor. Large central heads are followed by multiple side shoots for extended harvests. Strong disease resistance and great garden performance.	
Broccoli	Belstar 65 days	Heads are medium green and well domed with a medium-sized bead. Strong, stress-tolerant plants with good side-shoot production.	
Broccoli	Bravado 65 days	High-yielding hybrid variety reliably produces flavorful, tightly beaded, big, blue-green domed heads, followed by abundant crops of delicious side shoots to enjoy over a long extended season. Strong growing and disease-resistant.	
Broccoli	Burgundy 37 days	Abundant, concentrated side-shoot yields. This stunning sprouting broccoli has beautiful purple buds and purple-green stems. Slender stems with few leaves make for easy bunching.	
Broccoli	DiCicco 45 days	Vigorous plants yield 3-4", blue-green heads. After cutting the main head, more side shoots develop, producing many small to medium-sized heads through the season. Good for steaming, stir-fries and for freezing.	







<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Green Magic 57 days</p>	<p>Excellent heat tolerance. Heads are smooth, well-domed, and very attractive. Extremely uniform in maturity. Similar to Gypsy, but with a smaller plant, smoother heads, and better uniformity.</p>	
<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Gypsy 60 days</p>	<p>Strong root system for plantings in below-average fertility. Gypsy's heads are well-domed and uniform with a medium-small bead size and medium-sized stem. Intermediate resistance to downy mildew and good heat tolerance. Suitable for bunching or crown cut. Good side-shoot production.</p>	
<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Kariba 66 days</p>	<p>Cold tolerant for fall and winter production. A late-maturing variety with side shoot production</p>	
<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Marathon 68 days</p>	<p>This late variety is highly tolerant to cold. The large, blue-green heads have high, smooth, tight domes and small, fine beads. Plants produce heavy heads and have intermediate resistance to downy mildew.</p>	
<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Monty 56 days</p>	<p>Superior heat tolerance. An attractive broccoli with well-domed, bright green heads. Prolific side shoot production.</p>	

<p>Broccoli</p>	<p>Purple Magic 62 days</p>	<p>The well-domed heads are a beautiful deep purple overlaid on a dark green background with vibrant, bright violet stems. Suitable for bunching or crowns. 2024 AAS Winner</p>	
<p>Brussels Sprouts</p>	<p>Catskill 100 days</p>	<p>Delicious flavor, extra large sprouts that grow up to 2" round with medium green color. Catskill has large yields on strong stalks (24" tall) that make it easy to pick. This heirloom is great fresh eating or freezing.</p>	
<p>Brussels Sprouts</p>	<p>Dagan 100 days</p>	<p>Dependable midseason variety. Perfect for "on the stalk" sprouts. Smooth, attractive, and holds very well in the field compared to others. Tall plants. Medium-large sprouts.</p>	
<p>Brussels Sprouts</p>	<p>Gladius 98 days</p>	<p>Early and firm with great field-holding ability. Blue-green sprouts are uniform in size and color. Plants resist lodging. Medium-small sprouts.</p>	
<p>Brussels Sprouts</p>	<p>Silvia 100 days</p>	<p>Great choice for small gardens. Grows on a compact plant that reaches 2' tall. They may be short, but they are packed full of 45+ sprouts per stalk. Early maturing</p>	






Cabbage	Conehead 70 days	Solid, rounded, tightly wrapped base of leaves that taper to a point. Flavor is consistently mild and remarkably sweet. Heads grow quickly and are uniform and heavy for their size with strong wrapper leaves and great weather tolerance.	
Cabbage	Copenhagen Market 75 days	This early variety forms round, solid heads 6-8" in diameter, making it the largest early round-head cabbage for summer harvest.	
Cabbage	Early Jersey Wakefield 70 days	Early-maturing variety is delicious eaten fresh. The conical, solid, tightly held heads grow up to 15" long by 7" wide and weigh 3-4 pounds each.	
Cabbage	Red Acre 62 days	Red Acre is a fantastic cabbage that produces reddish-purple heads. Each cabbage head grows to 7 inches in diameter and weighs about 3 pounds. Red Acre is resistant to cabbage yellowing	
Cabbage	Sweet and Tender 71 days	Very tender and sweet with a nice, mild, cabbage flavor. Excellent for wraps, slaws, and light cooking. 3-4 lb.	

Cabbage (Napa)	One Kilo 55 days	A unique Japanese variety, this relatively small, elongated head is green with a soft, crinkly lemon-yellow heart.	
Cabbage (Napa)	Purple Express 75 days	The heavy, dense, deep purple-red heads are big, 10 to 12 inches tall, with excellent vigor and disease resistance.	
Cauliflower	Amazing Taste 60 days	Dense, 6-inch, dome-shaped heads with tender, creamy-white curds and superb mild, nutty-sweet flavor. Plants grow quickly, producing strong outer wrapper leaves that protect both the quality and color of the developing cauliflowers for harvestable heads extra early in the season.	
Cauliflower	Bishop 65 days	Has well-wrapped heads, excellent vigor, and wide adaptability.	
Cauliflower	Cheddar 58 days	This beautiful, early, orange cauliflower holds well in the field. It becomes an even brighter orange when lightly cooked.	

Cauliflower	Clementine 55 days	Vibrant orange. Big, sturdy plants produce excellent crops, even under less-than-ideal conditions. The earliest maturing orange variety.	
Cauliflower	Flame Star 62 days	Pastel orange cauliflower with improved heat tolerance. Medium-large plant. A paler orange than Cheddar, but exhibits better tolerance to heat and stress.	
Cauliflower	Fujiyama 45 days	Pproduces high-quality heads in warm weather and is an excellent choice for early fall harvested crops. Medium-large plant with an average wrap.	
Cauliflower	Lavender 70 days	Stems are a beautiful medium-purple. Compared to Graffiti, heads are a much brighter violet-purple and have a slightly larger dome.	
Cauliflower	Puntoverde 78 days	Reliable all-season Romanesco. Attractive, high-quality heads. Strong, rugged plants. Outperforms typical Romanesco types under stressful weather conditions.	

Cauliflower	Purple Crush 75 days	New cauliflower grows smoothly into big domed heads with a beautiful rich purple color and superb mild, nutty, sweet flavor.	
Cauliflower	Purple Moon 62 days	Exceptionally early purple cauliflower. Very attractive, medium-dark, purple heads perform well in warm weather.	
Cauliflower	Synergy 60 days	Adaptable midseason variety. Large, sturdy plants produce big, well-domed heads.	
Cauliflower	Vitaverde 71 days	Big, heavy, green heads mature early on large plants.	
Collard Greens	Georgia Southern 60-80 days	A true old southern favorite! Very tasty and flavorful. Heavy producer. Grows 2-3'H, upright with large yet with tender, mild and juicy blue-green crumpled leaves. Non-heading plant. Slow to bolt. Heat, cold and poor soil tolerant.	
Collard Greens	Green Flash 55 days	Dense, 18-inch tall rosettes of thick, tender, big paddle-shaped leaves. Uniformity, vigor, high yields, and bolt resistance. Rapid regrowth and longer, more dependable harvests. Cut the handsome leaves often to enjoy their flavorful, sweet taste.	

<p>Kale</p>	<p>Black Magic (Toscano) 62 days</p>	<p>Italian heirloom that dates back to the eighteenth century. Bluegreen strap-like leaves are 3" wide by 10-18" long with a heavily savoyed texture. Excellent flavor that is enhanced by frost. Best eaten when leaves are small and tender.</p>	
<p>Kale</p>	<p>Dazzling Blue 50 days</p>	<p>Dinosaur type kale that boasts unparalleled cold hardiness and fantastic purple and blue leaves.</p>	
<p>Kale</p>	<p>Dwarf Blue 55 days</p>	<p>Heirloom. Finely curled blue-green leaves are carried on compact, 1' plants. Extremely hardy and will overwinter</p>	
<p>Kale</p>	<p>Mars Landing 50 days</p>	<p>The tender leaves are a wonderful bronzy purple/maroon color with light green underneath and notched and scalloped edges. Tender, mild and very tasty. Holds well in the garden without getting tough or stringy</p>	
<p>Kale</p>	<p>Purple Moon 68 days</p>	<p>Beautiful frilled & ruffled, deep purple leaves that are loaded with great flavor & super nutrition. Grow vigorously, and can be harvested over a long, productive season.</p>

Kale	Scarlet 30-50 days	A lovely curled "red" kale that produces lots of delicious, frilly leaves and takes on the chill of winter with stride! Pretty in the flower garden or on the plate.
